



Driving Directions to Bantam Roost

From North (Denver / Boulder)

- Take Interstate 25 South to the Walsenburg, CO. exit.
- Follow CO Hwy 160 over La Veta Pass to Fort Garland, CO
- Turn left onto CO Hwy 159 South. Upon crossing the NM state line, CO Hwy 159 becomes NM Hwy 522.
- After you pass the small valley town of Arroyo Hondo, you'll arrive at the traffic light intersection of NM 522, NM 150 and NM 64. Here you'll be entering the Taos Valley.
- Continue straight, south toward the Town of Taos.
- The third traffic light will be at the intersection of **Camino de la Placita** to the right. Make a **RIGHT**
- At the next traffic light you'll make a **RIGHT** onto **Ranchitos Road**.
- Continue along Ranchitos Road for approximately 2 miles.
- You'll pass the **Martinez Hacienda Museum** on your **right side**. This is your landmark.
- Almost immediately after the Martinez Hacienda, look on your **left side** for a **4 mile marker**.
- **Immediately after the 4 mile marker on your left is a dirt road called Callejon Road.**
- **Make a LEFT** on to **Callejon Road**. Callejon Road is a sometimes bumpy dirt road, so take it slowly and weave your way through a few curves past the melting adobe ruins on your left (about a quarter of a mile – no more). **Look for the first Casa Gallina sign on your left – This is not your casita ... continue past this first sign to the next house (#609) on your left, the first arched driveway is my home, the second driveway just past the yellow adobe wall is The Bantam Roost. (Look for the sign on the road with a colorful rooster!)**
- Pull into the parking spot furthest to the back of the parking area.

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
